This award **MUST** be used at an accredited college or university of the applicant's choice for UNDERGRADUATE studies. GRADUATE School does **NOT** apply.
(Each Applicant is given consideration by an unbiased Committee)

DEADLINE: Friday, August 6, 2021 AT 1630 HOURS

Any application received after the close of business (1630 hours) on Friday, August 6, 2021 will not be considered.

- 1) **IF A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT** - A COPY OF YOUR LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE AND A 2021 FALL COURSE COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT.
- 2) **IF ATTENDING COLLEGE** - A PRESENT 2021 FALL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT.
- 3) **COMPLETED APPLICATION.**
